BOOK LIBRARY

This will begin during the first couple of weeks in September. We change your child's library book once a week. If your child enjoys the nursery library you can also join the local library in town to borrow books to share with your child.

We provide snack (fruit) for your child and water or milk.

Please only send <u>WATER</u> to nursery with your child in a named water bottle- <u>NO JUICE</u>. We follow the healthy schools policy.

Please <u>DO NOT</u> send any <u>NUT</u> products into nursery due to serious allergies.

Grapes should be cut in half.

No chocolates or sweets in lunch boxes please.

Tapestry is the online learning journal that we use. In line with the new EYFS curriculum you may see less observations and photographs on there than previously as the focus is on staff spending more time interacting with the children rather than making lots of observations. We will observe and record key milestones. Please add any photographs and comments onto the journal that your child has achieved at home.

There are people to help with a variety of situations which parents and children face. We all need support at times!

If you need support or advice please speak with us as we can put you in touch with various professionals to help such as, the children's centre, parent support advisor, health visitor, speech and language team, toddler groups and community teams and support opportunities.

- Please make sure your child has a named bag with a couple of spare changes of clothes, nappies (if they use them) and wipes.
- Please ensure your child comes into nursery in a clean nappy.
- Please ensure your child has a named water bottle.
- Lunchboxes need to be named.
- Please hand any inhalers into a member of staff.
- Your child will need a coat and closed toed-shoes in nursery.

Please let us know if you change address or any of your contact details change.

It is essential you contact us every-day your child is absent for whatever reason.

You must be contactable during the time your child is in nursery. If you can't be contacted we will phone others on your list of contacts.

Please play games with your child, build and construct, draw, colour, paint and most importantly of all talk with your child and encourage their language development.

If you would like some activities to try at home we can give you some ideas from our 'Chatting with children programme'!

All these things will support your child to reach age appropriate attainment and the ability to communicate verbally will minimise frustration and upset.
