Masie says:

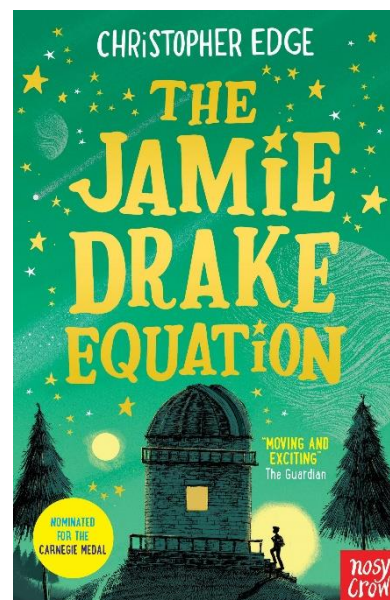
