

#### Secondary School Applications for September 2023

Parents who applied online before the 31 October 2022 and selected to receive their decision by email, will be sent an email confirming the school place offered to their child. Parents who selected to receive their decision by the Parent Portal, will need to log into the Portal using their email address and password to view the outcome. If you no longer have your password, you will be able to reset this using the online system.

All applicants who applied before the 31 October 2022 must accept or decline the place that is being offered by 15 March 2023 as the portal will close after this date. Local councils will send out letters confirming primary school places on **Monday April** 17, 2023. Letters are sent to your home address and state whether your child has been offered a place at any of the schools you applied for last year. Normally, they send out the offer letters on April 16
