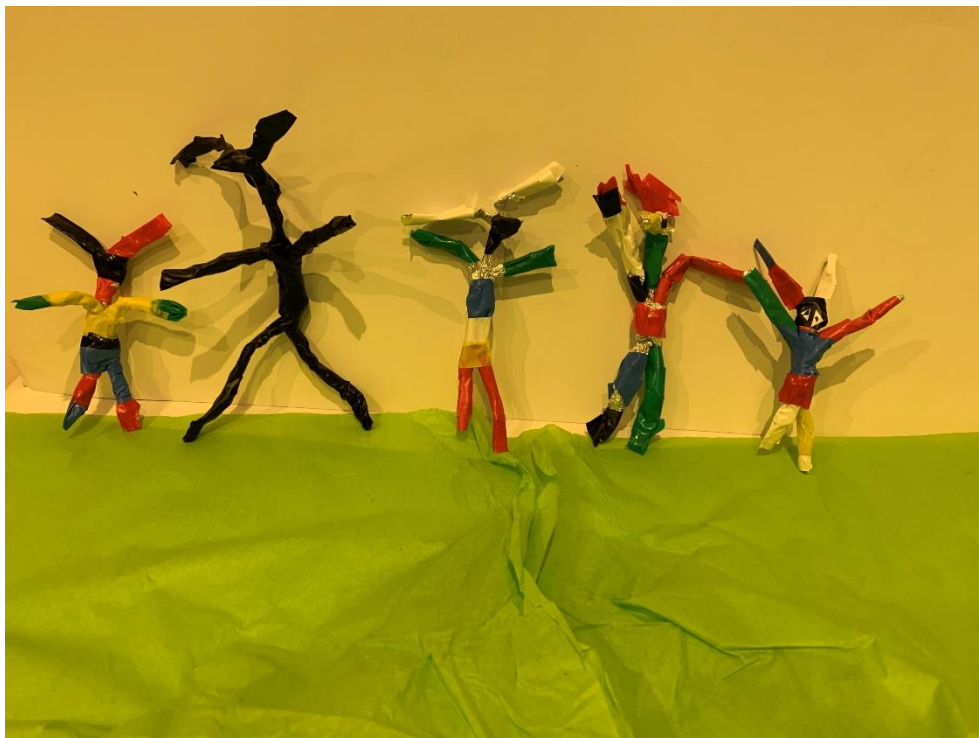


## The Attendance Cup

**Kindness, Respect, Community and Aspiration** form our other core Values.

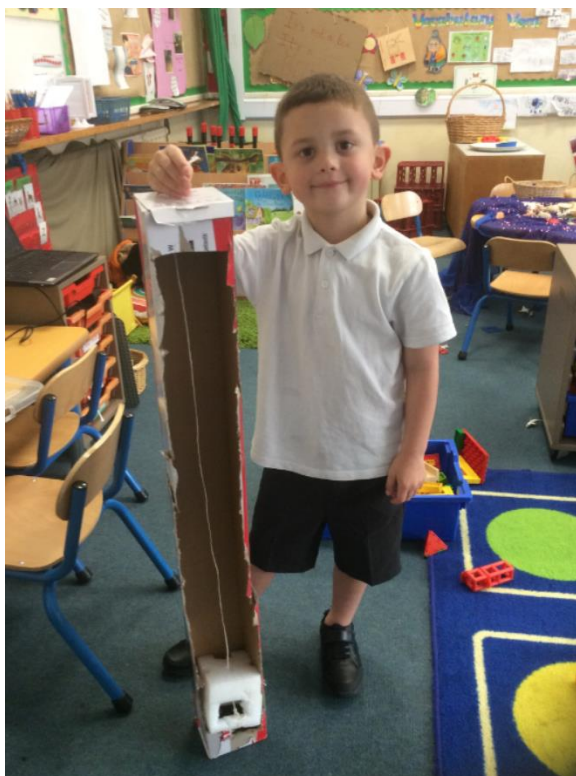
## The CARROT Cup – Courtesy And Respect Reward Orange Token
