Woodlands Primary School – Timetable Changes 2024/25

As with many schools, from September there will be changes to our school start times.

'The Government is determined that all pupils have the opportunity to achieve their full academic potential.' To support this, the Government has introduced a new minimum expectation on the length of the school week for all mainstream, state-funded schools.

The changes below will ensure we are meeting these requirements.

The school gates will be open from 8:40, this is the time children should begin to enter their classrooms. Children should be in class by 8:50 for registration and the start of lessons.

We hope you view this as a positive change that will ensure your children are getting the very most out of their school day.

Any children arriving after the register closes at 9:00 will be marked as late. Children arriving late to school can impact on their learning and achievement.

We will also be altering our daily timetable within school hours.
