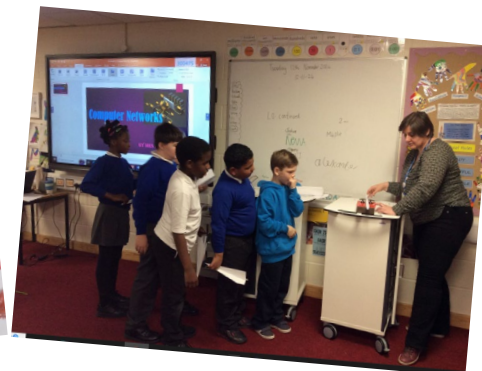
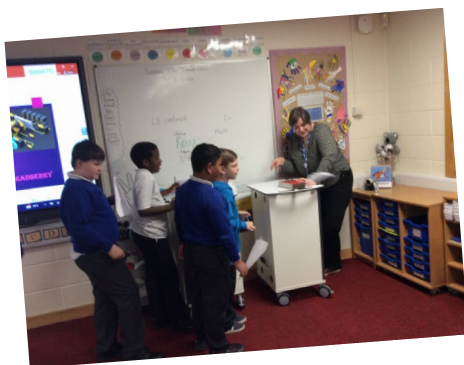
### Headteachers' Awards

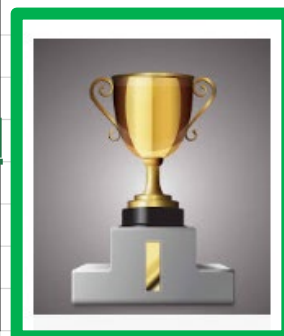
### Spotlight on the Curriculum – New After School Clubs – Science Club & Art Club
