

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

On Time: First Time, Every Time



DFE research states:

'Being in school is important to your child's achievement, wellbeing, wider development. Evidence shows that the students with the highest attendance throughout their time in school gain the best GCSE and A Level results. Our research found that pupils who performed better both at the end of primary and sec. school missed fewer days than those who didn't perform as well.'

High attendance continues to be a priority for our school and we will always try and offer support where issues exist around a child obtaining strong attendance. The Department of Education has published statutory documentation 'Working Together to Improve School Attendance' for schools which came into force from August 2024. The guidance makes it very clear that schools will very rarely be able to grant leave of absence for a child and that no holidays at all can be authorised within the school term. There is also a new framework for Fixed Penalty Notices and all unauthorised holidays will have to be fined. We will always try to work with our families and children to support attendance and any wider issues which is preventing a child securing strong attendance. We really do want to work with you to ensure a comprehensive approach so that that your child has the opportunity to benefit fully from their education. Thank you for your continued support and many of our children have had excellent attendance this year.

On a positive note, at the end of last term we were able to award **41** attendance medals, to children who had attended school every school day from 3rd September to 18th December. We will be issuing medals again at Easter for any children who have come to school every school day from 5th January to 27th March.

On top of this, we are still holding the monthly duck races, where any child who has 100% attendance that month is given a duck in the race to win a shopping voucher. The children love the thrill of the race and it gives children that may not achieve a full term attendance medal, due to sickness, another chance to be recognised.
