## Spotlight on the Curriculum – Reception (Acorn Class) – Outdoor Learning

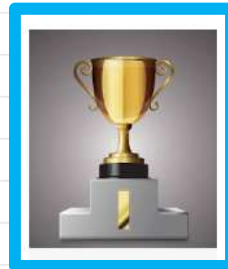
