Key Stage 2 - Bump Up Morning Photos – Meet the New Teacher

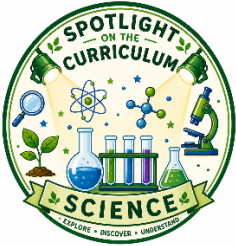
