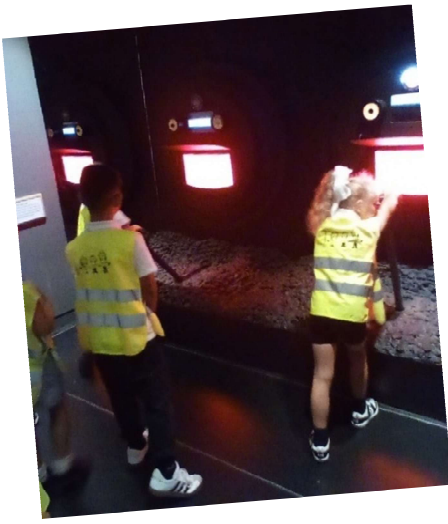
Dear Parents and Carers,

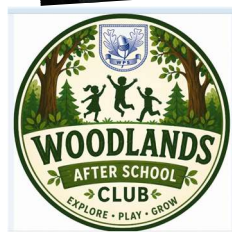
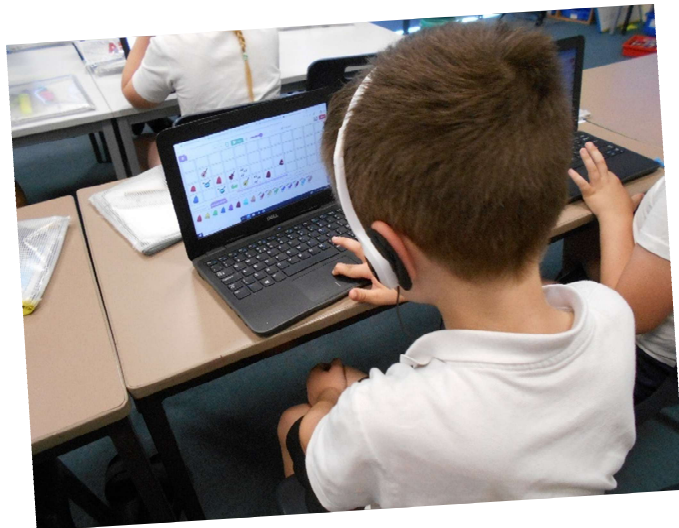






Year 3 – Music & Computing
